When we view the book of Mark, we will not find the lineage of Christ as we find in Luke and Matthew because Mark views him as a servant. It is this servant's heart, this submissive spirit that Christ displayed that made possible for us redemption and all it entails.

Mark 14:32-42

# I. Why Did He Submit?

Submission is simply the act of yielding to a superior force or will of authority.

## A. Christ's Position in the Trinity

The Bible distinctly declares there is one God.

Isaiah 45:5 KJV 1900

I am the LORD, and there is none else, There is no God beside me: I girded thee, though thou hast not known me:

During the times of the Old Testament, a major problem was the belief in many gods. This is the concept of Polytheism. This system of thought and teaching still exists today in various religious systems like: Hinduism, Mahayana Buddhism, Confucianism, Taoism, and Shintoism.

Mark 12:29 KJV 1900

And Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments *is*, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord:

But the Bible also teaches that God exists as a Trinity. This is literally a Tri-unity, or Three in one.

1 John 5:7 KJV 1900

For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.

Christ holds a valuable position, HE IS GOD!

J.Vernon McGee stated, "We mean three persons in the Godhead. In the Westminster Confession of Faith the question is asked: "How many persons are there in the Godhead?" The answer is: "There are three persons in the Godhead: the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost; and these three are one God, the same in substance, equal in power and glory."

1 Timothy 2:5 KJV 1900

For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

# B. Christ's Prayer of Submission

**Prayer reveals his trust.** The term, "Be sore amazed" is the Greek word *ekthambeo* it means to alarm thoroughly, to terrify.

Colossians 2:14 KJV 1900

Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;

Psalm 112:7 KJV 1900

He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: His heart is fixed, trusting in the LORD.

**Prayer reveals His obedience.** Notice in verse 36, Christ in His prayer to the Father calls Him ABBA. This wonderfully endearing term expressing warm affection and honor toward His Father. It has no perfect equivalent in our language.
